Thanks Colin. Just as a reminder, please find below our lines on leaked CETA text:

Q. Is [leaked text X] what Canada agreed to in CETA?

- Canada does not comment on leaks of purported negotiating texts.
- Now that the technical issues in the negotiations are resolved, Canada and the EU will proceed with a thorough legal review of the text to ensure accuracy and consistency. This will be followed by translation of the text into the other 22 EU treaty languages.
- The CETA text will be available at the earliest opportunity.
